When we study God's Word we are reminded to stand firm, focus on our eternal hope, and rejoice in the Lord.

The Bible tells us to fix our eyes on Jesus (Hebrews 12:2), to cease striving and know that He is God (Psalm 46:10), and to remember the Lord who is great and awesome (Nehemiah 4:14) so that we do not grow weary and lose heart while we await His return.

When disappointment or discouragement threaten to steal our peace and cause us to lose our focus, God's Word has the solution: Meditate on His Word (Psalm 1) and think about things that are true, honorable, just, pure, lovely, commendable, and worthy of praise (Philippians 4:8).

Memorizing Scripture is one of the most powerful tools we have for combating the enemy's schemes to put out our light and keep us from pressing on.
